GUIDELINES FOR POSTER- MAKING CONTEST

POSTER-SLOGAN MAKING CONTEST

ELIGIBILITY

1. All participants should register at the Designated Registration Committee
 - > shall submit the official names of the contestants to the **Department of Education Technical Working Group** on or before **August 22, 2016**
2. Participants shall be a bonafide Grade 11 student and currently enrolled in a public/private school of the city.
3. Each contestant shall have only one entry for the poster making contest.

MECHANICS

1. All participants' posters and slogan should be completed/finished a day before the activity proper (August 25, 2016).
2. The poster and slogan must expound on the theme **“Sama-samang Hanapin, Gamutin, Pagalingin LAHAT! END TB: A Paradigm Shift to Fight Against TB and HIV”**
3. The contestants are responsible for the provision of their own art materials: **one half (1/2) illustration board, a set of oil pastel, pentel pen, pencil, eraser, cotton, ballpen.**
4. A slogan which shall serve as the title of the art work must not exceed fifteen (15) words in English.
5. The finished artworks will be displayed in the entrance of the venue for the guest and participants to see and judge. Participants should be present in the venue one (1) hour prior to the start of the activity proper.

6. For the purpose of anonymity, the artist's real name, school and other contact details must only appear in the official registration form.

7. The contestant number shall be attached to the upper right hand corner of the illustration board.

8. The use of mobile phones and other devices is prohibited during the contest proper.

9. Contestant is not allowed to go out once the contest has started.
